STAFF CHANGES FOR 2019-20:

- 2014 - 2019 Enrollment decline of 95 students.
- 2014 - 2019 Staff increase from 88 to 90 teachers
- 2019-20 SWSD will right size based upon seniority and needs
- April 15th: preliminary notification of possible impacts
- May 15th: State Deadline for Actual Impacts
- Planned Changes for 2019-20:
 - 5 FTE reduction at HS
 - 6 staff reassignments

PROGRAM CHANGES FOR 2019-20:

- SWHS Shop will now be known as Project Gateway and will incorporate robotics and additional hands on options
- SWHS Art reduced due to lack of student interest
- SWSD Garden will continue with SWSD specialist for K-6 program
- K-4 class size, K-3 program ratio will be reduce to 17:1
